### Permanently Secured Identification Device

Laptop computers, cellular telephones, pagers, and stereo equipment are permanently marked with a Patented Security Device:

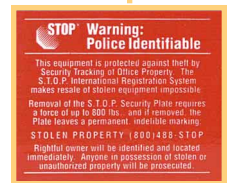
A Security Plate is sealed to the case (requiring up to 800 pounds of force to remove). The plate bears a unique ID Number, a message and an 800 number to call for ownership verification and anti-theft information.

An Indelible Tattoo, underneath the plate, is automatically, chemically etched into the case when sealing the plate.

A bright red Police Identifiable Warning Sticker adds to the deterrence effectiveness.

If a thief succeeds in removing the plate, a "Stolen Property" message permanently imbedded in the casing would be revealed with the 800 security phone number.

This device makes the computer and other electronic items worthless for thieves since it is virtually impossible to resell. It also allows rapid tracking of lost or misplaced equipment.



### 24-Hour Ownership Verification Database

Each plate ID number is registered in the S.T.O.P. International Database, along with the equipment description (type, brand, model, serial number) and ownership information. The registration is valid for three years.

A simple call to S.T.O.P quickly verifies the legitimate owner.

In the case of stolen property, immediately upon your reporting to the Anti-Theft Hotline, 1-800-488-STOP. S.T.O.P. will help you notify the local police, register your property with the FBI and INTERPOL.

The STOP security plate thus makes computers and other electronic items worthless for thieves, since STOP-secured items are virtually impossible to resell. Our unique anti-theft system also allows rapid tracking of lost or misplaced equipment.

## Safeguarding Your Laptop

Laptop computers are portable, concealable and expensive. Also, they usually contain valuable information. This makes laptops a prime target for theft. There are several security measures you can take to protect your laptop.



### Office, Lab, Dorm

1. Never leave your laptop unsecured and unattended. (Even for short durations.)

- Close and lock your door.
- Lock the laptop in a drawer or file cabinet.
- Use a security device. (Cable, lockdown or operation identification.)
- If you bring the laptop with you, never leave it unattended.



2. Place a S.T.O.P. security plate on the laptop. Maintain make, model, and serial number in a separate location. The police will need this information in case your computer is lost or stolen.



3. Register with S.T.O.P. Contact your campus police crime prevention officer on how to register your laptop with the S.T.O.P. program.

### Vehicles

4. Never leave your laptop in the passenger compartment of your car. If you must leave your laptop in the car, lock it in the trunk out of sight before you reach your destination.



5. Report suspicious persons and activity to campus security/police immediately.
